## MARZ INTENDS TO HOST OPEN AIR GROCERY STORES ON SUNDAYS IN JUNE/JULY IN A WAY THAT COMPLIES WITH ALL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS DURING COVID-19





### Why We Are Hosting these Farmers' Markets

- Farmers are struggling: a major goal is to help small farmers who are struggling right now and whose crops are literally wasting in the fields
- City folks have limited access to fresh produce. They also find shopping at large grocery stores to be challenging or uncomfortable right now
- Marz has a team that wants to do something to help, but Marz will make no money off these events

#### **How It Will Work**

- Safety First: open air, more than 600 feet per person provides ample space for physical distancing, transactions will be touchless and cashless
- Limited Participation: participation will be subject to reservation and open to the public
- Rules will be Enforced: Marz will provide staff for check-in, check-out and make sure flow is proper to provide for social distancing

# ONLY ALLOWING 20 CUSTOMERS AT A TIME PROVIDES MORE THAN 600 FEET PER PERSON, INCLUDING VENDORS, WHICH IS WELL ABOVE SUPERMARKET STANDARDS

Farmers' Market will be limited to no more than 10 vendors providing ~30 feet between tents

Vendor Stations (not to scale)

Uncovered parking lot is 150 feet long and more than 110 feet wide, resulting in approximately 16,500 square feet of space for the market

Vast space and limited participation allows for physical distancing

Queuing will take place in the private alley lot so that sidewalks remain unobstructed



### IN ADDITION TO GREAT PHYSICAL SEPARATION, WE WILL PROVIDE A CASH-LESS EXPERIENCE WITH MINIMAL TOUCHPOINTS



Upon arrival, customers will wait on marked X spots at least 6 feet apart until called into the market



Gloves and masks required for both vendors and customers
Purchases will be cashless and touchless: customers will provide a card online when they register, and vendors will charge at end of day
